Horse Trials & Combined Test Class List

Divisions will run from large to small (Prelim-Tadpole)

1. Tadpole Horse Trial (poles on the ground)
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test A. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will not exceed poles on the ground
XC: Jumps will consist of natural poles on the ground. 6-8 jumping efforts
2. Pre-Green Horse Trial (up to 12")
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test A. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals & cross rails. Will not exceed 12"
XC: Jumps will consist of raised natural poles & logs not exceeding 12". 6-8 jumping efforts
3. Green Horse Trial (up to 18")
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals & cross rails. Will not exceed 18"
XC: Jumps will consist of raised natural poles & logs not exceeding 18". 6-8 jumping efforts. Water will be optional
4. Advanced Green Horse Trial (up to 2'0")
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test C. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals & cross rails. Will not exceed 2'0"
XC: Jumps will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. not exceeding 2'. 10-12 jumping efforts. Water may be optional, may consist of small banks and faux ditch.
5. Pre-Beginner Novice Horse Trial (up to 2'3")
Dressage: USEA 2022 Starter Test. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, cross rails, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 2'3"
XC: Jumps will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. not exceeding 2'3". 10-12 jumping efforts. May consist of small banks, water and ditch.
6. Beginner Novice Horse Trial (up to 2'7")
Dressage: USEF 2022 Beginner Novice Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 2'7"
XC: Jumps will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. not exceeding 2'7". 14-16 jumping efforts. May consist of small banks, water and ditch.

7. Novice Horse Trial (up to 2'11)
Dressage: USEF 2022 Novice Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 2'11
XC: Jumps will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. not exceeding 2'11. 16-18 jumping efforts. May consist of banks, water and ditch.
8. Training/Novice Horse Trial (up to 3'3)
Dressage: USEF 2022 Training Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 3'3
XC: Jumps will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. Will jump novice XC unless entries permit for a training course.
9. Leadline Combined Test (poles on the ground)
Dressage: VA Eventing Leadline Test. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Shortened course. Jumps will not exceed poles on the ground.
10. Tadpole Combined Test (poles on the ground)
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test A. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will not exceed poles on the ground.
11. Pre-Green Combined Test (up to 12")
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test A. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals & cross rails. Will not exceed 12"
12. Green Combined Test (up to 18")
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals & cross rails. Will not exceed 18"
13. Advanced Green Combined Test (up to 2'0)
Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test C. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals & cross rails. Will not exceed 2'0
14. Pre-Beginner Novice Combined Test (up to 2'3)
Dressage: USEA 2022 Starter Test. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 2'3
15. Beginner Novice Combined Test (up to 2'7)
Dressage: USEF 2022 Beginner Novice Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 2'7
16. Novice Combined Test (up to 2'11)
Dressage: USEF 2022 Novice Test B. Small Arena.
Show Jumping: Jumps will consist of verticals, oxers & combinations. Will not exceed 2'11
17. Training Combined Test (up to 3'3)
Dressage: USEF 2022 Training Test B. Small Arena.

General Conditions and Rules

Entry Fees:

Horse Trial: \$110 per Horse Trial

Combined Test: \$80 per combined test

Dressage Test Only: \$35 per test

Show Jump Only: \$30 per class

****ONLINE ENTRIES ARE SUBJECT TO A \$5.00 PROCESSING & CONVENIENCE FEE****

1. There will be six ribbon places per division.
2. Entries must include full payment, current Coggins test, signed Release, and mailed to the Secretary or entered online
3. Combined tests competitors may enter more than one consecutive combined test. Multiple dressage tests may be ridden by all competitors.
4. The same horse/rider combination must perform all phases of the competition.
5. ASTM/SEI approved protective helmets must be worn by riders at all times when mounted.
6. USEA medical armbands are recommended during jumping phases but are not required.
7. Eventing Dressage tests must be ridden from memory and must be ridden in approved snaffle bits.
8. Dressage Only tests may use a caller for their test. Riders must provide their own test caller.
9. Schooling in the dressage and stadium arenas is not permitted.
10. Jumps are provided in warm-up areas and must be jumped in the direction flagged —red flags on your right.
11. Time for walking the stadium course will be provided before each division.
12. Due to safety reasons, NO DOGS are allowed on grounds. Please leave your four legged friends at home.
13. This is a non-sanctioned combined test & dressage show, but run in accordance with USEF/USEA rules.
14. No refunds permitted after closing date. Entries scratched before CD include \$25 non-refundable office fee.
15. All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit.
16. Junior competitors are anyone under 18 years of age within their birth year.
17. Ride times will be posted by 10PM the Friday before event on www.VAEventing.com
18. Dress: Casual but neat. Proper from the waist down, polo shirt acceptable.
19. Events are RAIN or SHINE unless severe weather is forecasted, then show will be rescheduled. We will monitor weather closely.
20. Please make checks payable to Oakdale Farm
21. Returned checks are subject to a \$50 returned check fee
22. Non-Compete horses are allowed, FEE \$30—Must check in with show secretary
