Fees:

Draw checks to VA Eventing. Only ONE check needed for all horses if being ridden by the same rider. Online entries are subject to a \$7 processing fee.

Entries:

On-Line entries accepted with credit card payment only - NO checks. Online entries are subject to a \$5 processing fee. Mail-in entries must be accompanied by check. **Entries submitted without payment will not receive start times** . All entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee. \$50 return check fee. Competitor Information

Awards: Prizes & 6 ribbons per division, divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit

Arenas & Warm-up: Sand base, all-weather footing. Some grass warm up for jumping

Divisions & Tests

Leadline- VA Eventing Leadline Test (please contact show secretary for a copy of the test)

- SJ Jump test will be a modified course of 5-6 poles on the ground

Tadpole & Pre-Green-2023 USDF Introductory Test A

- Tadpole jump test will consist of 10 jumps with poles on the ground
- Pre-Green jump test will consist of 10 jumps of x-rail & verticals that do not exceed 12"
- XC jump test will consist of raised rails on the ground over rolling terrain. Water will be an option but rider must get through the very WIDE flags

Green- 2023 USDF Introductory Test B

- Green jump test will consist of 10 jumps of x-rails & verticals that do not exceed 18". Flower boxes may be added
- XC jump test will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. Water will be optional, but riders MUST go through very WIDE flags

Advanced Green -2026 USEA Starter Test A

- Advanced Green jump test will consist of 10 jumps of verticals, planks & added flower boxes not exceeding 2'
- XC jump test will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. Water will be optional, but riders MUST go through WIDE flags

Starter-2026 USEA Starter Test A

- Starter jump test will consist of 10 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks & fillers not to exceed 2'3. TIMED
- XC jump test will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, etc. Water will be optional, but riders MUST go through widened flags. Ditch option could also be on a course.

Beginner Novice-2026 USEF Beginner Novice Test A

- Beginner Novice jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 2'7
- XC jump test will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, water ditches, tables, etc. Jumps to be seen at this level.

Novice- 2026 USEF Novice Test A

- Novice jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 2'11
- XC jump test will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, water ditches, tables, etc. Jumps to be seen at this level.

Training-2026 USEF Training Test A

- Training jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 3'3
- XC jump test will consist of logs, coops, roll tops, water ditches, tables, etc. Jumps to be seen at this level.

Modified/Prelim- USEF 2022 Modified Test A/USEF 2022 Prelim Test A

- Modified & Prelim jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 3'5(M)/3'7(P)

Dressage Only:

All current USEF, USEA, USDF, WDAA, NWA, WE, Musical Freestyle tests available

Guidelines & Rules:

The **VA Eventing & Dressage Series**: will award High Point prizes to Horse & Rider combinations competing in all levels. Compete in 5 competitions to qualify for year-end awards (same horse/rider/division). Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses per rider per division. Dogs must be leashed.

1. Combined test competitors may enter more than one consecutive combined test. Multiple dressage tests may be ridden by all competitors.
2. The same horse/rider combination must perform all phases of the competition.
3. ASTM/SEI approved protective helmet must be worn **AT ALL TIMES** when mounted.
4. Eventing dressage tests must be ridden from memory & must be ridden in approved snaffle bit
5. Dressage only division tests may use a caller for their test. Riders **MUST** provide their own test caller
6. Schooling in the dressage & SJ arenas is not permitted
7. Jumps are provided in the warm-up arena & must be jumped the flagged direction (red right/white left)
8. Time for walking the show jumping course will be provided before each division
9. Please keep your dogs on a leash & attached to a human **AT ALL TIMES**. Loose dogs are subject to a \$50 fine. Unruly dogs will be asked to leave the premises **IMMEDIATELY**.
10. This is a non-sanctioned combined test & dressage show, but will run in accordance with USEF/USEA rulebook. Please refer to the rulebook [USEA/USEF RULE BOOK](#)
11. No refunds permitted after closing date. Entries scratched before CD include \$25 non-refundable office fee
12. All divisions will be split JR/SR if entries permit
13. Junior competitors apply to anyone under the age of 18 within their birth year
14. Ride times will be posted on our website www.VAEventing.com and emailed to all competitors LATE PM the Friday before each event. Please make sure your email address is correct on your entry form!
15. Dress: Casual but neat. Proper attire from the waist down. Polo shirts are acceptable. Paddock boots & half chaps are also acceptable. Show jackets are not required.
16. Events are **RAIN** or **SHINE** unless severe weather is forecasted. The show will then be rescheduled (typically the following weekend) We do monitor the weather closely. Competitors are encouraged to check their email often leading up to the event, especially if the weather could be questionable.
17. Please remember this is a **SCHOOLING EVENT**. This is an opportunity for everyone to learn with the respect of other competitors. We encourage riders, coaches, family & team members to ask questions. We are always happy to educate!
18. Questions about proper tack?! Please refer to the USEA/USEF Rule Book. NO standing martingales allowed. NO boots (brushing/bell/splint, etc) allowed in dressage. NO dressage whips allowed show jumping. Safety vests ARE required for the XC phase of the competition.
