**Draw checks to Deep Run Hunt Pony Club (DRHPC).** Only ONE check needed for all horses if being ridden by the same rider. Online entries are subject to a \$10 processing fee.

Awards: Prizes & 6 ribbons per division, divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit

Arenas & Warm-up: Sand base, all-weather footing. Some grass warm up for jumping

### **Divisions & Tests**

#### **Tadpole** -2023 USDF Introductory Test A

- Tadpole jump test will consist of 10 jumps with poles on the ground

#### **Cross Rails**- 2023 USDF Introductory Test B

- Cross Rails jump test will consist of 10 jumps of x-rails that do not exceed 18".

#### **Introductory Novice & Starter** -2026 USEA Starter Test A

- Introductory jump test will consist of 10 jumps of verticals, planks & added flower boxes not exceeding 2'
- Starter jump test will consist of 10 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks & fillers not to exceed 2'3. TIMED
- XC appropriate for each level. Rolling terrain. Logs, coops, houses, etc.

#### **Beginner Novice**-2026 USEF Beginner Novice Test A

- Beginner Novice jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 2'7
- XC appropriate for the level consisting of banks, ditches, water, logs, tables, etc.

#### **Novice**- 2026 USEF Novice Test A

- Novice jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 2'11
- XC appropriate for the level consisting of banks, ditches, water, logs, tables, etc.

#### **Training**-2026 USEF Training Test A

- Training jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 3'3
- XC appropriate for the level consisting of banks, ditches, water, logs, tables, etc.

#### **Modified**- USEF 2026 Modified Test A

- Modified jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 3'5

#### **Preliminary**- USEF 2026 Preliminary Test A

- Prelim jump test will consist of 11 jumps of verticals, oxers, planks, fillers & combinations not to exceed 3'7

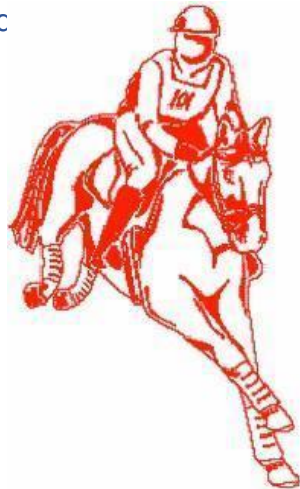

## **Guidelines & Rules:**

1. There will be six ribbons places per division. Ribbons will only be provided in divisions with more than 1 rider.
2. Show is limited to 150 entries. Enter early. Entries will close early if limit is reached. Entries will then be waitlisted.
3. No refunds after closing date without veterinary certificate; refunds before closing date minus \$25 office fee.
4. Combined tests competitors MAY enter two consecutive combined test divisions
5. The same horse/rider combination must perform all phases of the competition.
6. ***ASTM/SEI approved protective helmets must be worn by riders at all times when mounted.***
7. USEA medical armbands are recommended during jumping phases but are not required.
8. (CT)Dressage test must be ridden from memory and must be ridden in approved snaffle bits.
  - a. Pure dressage may have a caller. Riders must provide their own callers
9. Schooling in the dressage, cross-country, and stadium areas is not permitted.
10. Jumps are provided in warm-up areas and must be jumped in the direction flagged —red flags on your right.
11. Time for walking the stadium course will be provided before each division.
12. A veterinarian will be on call.
13. All dogs MUST be leashed while on grounds.
14. This is a non-sanctioned combined test & dressage show but run in accordance with USEF/USEA rules.
15. All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit.
16. Ride times will be posted on Pony Club website & emailed to all competitors. Ride times will be available after 10PM Thursday before the event.
17. Dress: Casual but neat. Proper attire from the waist down. Polo shirts are acceptable. Paddock boots & half chaps are also acceptable. Show jackets are not required.
18. Events are **RAIN** or **SHINE** unless severe weather is forecasted. We do monitor the weather closely. Competitors are encouraged to check their email often leading up to the event, especially if the weather could be questionable.
19. Questions about proper tack?! Please refer to the USEA/USEF Rule Book. NO standing martingales allowed. NO boots (brushing/bell/splint, etc) allowed in dressage. NO dressage whips allowec
